



Dear Chapter Member,

Is your house of worship serving your communication needs and others in the congregation with hearing loss by providing an assistive listening system other than the Public Address (PA) system? If not, or if you don't know, we need your help.

Our chapter is interested in working with you to address this problem by meeting with officials at your house of worship to introduce them to the hearing loop. This is the same technology we use here at our chapter meetings which allows you, by turning on the telecoils in your hearing aids or cochlear implants, to better hear and understand spoken information with reduced background noise.

We created a Get in the Hearing Loop Advocacy Committee with trained advocates to explain the benefits of installing hearing loops in the sanctuary and any other large meeting area. They are prepared to make a presentation to officials and key personnel at your house of worship, answer questions, and provide referrals to local installers of hearing loops.

You are in a position to open a discussion about improving communication access at worship services with officials at your facility by installing a hearing loop for people with hearing loss. Please help us help you and others who have hearing loss by taking on the challenge of arranging a meeting with our GITHL advocate. If the officials at your house of worship express interest in meeting with our chapter's GITHL advocate to learn more about loop technology and its benefits, please obtain the contact information for the advocate. You are welcome and encouraged to attend the meeting if you wish. Your continued involvement is not required.
